Dear Professor Riehm:

The 2025 Annual Report for the Master of Architecture program at University of Louisiana at Lafayette was reviewed during the April 17-18, 2026, meeting of the Board of Directors of the National Architectural Accrediting Board (NAAB).

Based on the review of the Annual Report, the NAAB directors voted to accept the Annual Report and require a Special Report to address the following areas:

Condition 6.2 Access to NAAB Conditions and Procedures

The program must provide working, publicly available links, via its website, to the current NAAB 2020 Conditions and Procedures. The program must also specify, via its website, the edition of the NAAB Procedures (2015 or 2020, depending on the date of the visit) in effect at the time of the program's last site visit, and provide publicly available links to this document.

Condition 6.6 Student Financial Information

The program must provide evidence that current and prospective students have access to initial estimates for all costs that may be required during the full course of study for the NAAB-accredited degree program. This information should include not only tuition and fees but also the cost of books, general supplies, and any specialized materials required for a student to participate in the architecture program. The information must be posted online and easily available to the public.

The program must provide a narrative and supporting evidence to demonstrate compliance with the Condition(s) noted. The Special Report is due no later than June 30, 2026.
