Parent PLUS Loan

Parents of dependent undergraduate students may apply for a Federal Direct Parent PLUS Loan at studentaid.gov/plus-app.

If the parent is approved:

- The parent may borrow **up to \$20,000 per academic year** (or the student's remaining cost of attendance, whichever is lower).

If the parent is denied:

- The student becomes eligible for **additional Direct Unsubsidized Loan funds**:
 - Up to \$4,000 per year** (0-59 earned credit hours)
 - Up to \$5,000 per year** (60+ earned credit hours)

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
