### Referendum

**WHEREAS** The University of Louisiana at Lafayette currently has Athletic Club Sports in the following areas of competition: Judo, Bowling, Soccer, Rugby, Tae Kwon Do, Skeet Shooting, and Water Skiing.

**AND WHEREAS** many of these teams excel to the highest degree in national and international competitions.

**AND WHEREAS** all of these programs represent the University and its students in all of these competitions, bringing positive recognition to the University.

**AND WHEREAS** all of these programs currently receive less than \$5,000 annually (\$.15 per student per semester) to be divided amongst all of them.

**AND WHEREAS** stronger funding is critical in sustaining these already successful teams.


**AND WHEREAS** the newly generated monies will go towards buying equipment, enhancing facilities, travel, recruitment, and marketing.

**AND WHEREAS** an additional \$3.00 per student per semester (Fall, Spring, and Summer) would generate adequate monies for each of these programs.

**AND WHEREAS** these sports currently receive minimal funding from the University, with much of the remaining funding coming from personal financial support.

**BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED THAT** the question be posed to the students on the Spring 2002 ballot "Should the students assess themselves an additional \$3.00 per student per semester (Fall, Spring, and Summer) to help in supporting all UL Lafayette Club Sports, with \$1.50 going towards the sports which include Judo, Bowling, Soccer, Rugby, Tae Kwon Do, and Skeet Shooting; \$1.00 going towards Water Skiing; and \$.50 going towards the UL Lafayette Spirit groups?"


