A REFERENDUM

WHEREAS the SGA Daycare Center is dedicated to providing top quality childcare at marginal prices for full time students with children.

AND WHEREAS those prices are as follows:

\$200 a month – five days/week

\$126 a month – three days/week

\$86 a month – two days/week

AND WHEREAS in the SGA Daycare Center, greater than 92% of all children in the facility are children of full time students.

AND WHEREAS every employee has completed an associate degree in child development and been certified or has been military certified in childcare.

AND WHEREAS the pay scale for the employees is not very flexible.

AND WHEREAS currently, the Daycare Center pays their employees as follows:

teacher #1 – yrs. experience - \$10,200 (full time)

teacher #2 – yrs. experience - \$10,200 (full time)

teacher #3 – yrs. experience - \$10,400 (full time)

teacher #4 – 6 yrs. experience \$13,600 (full time)

teacher #5 – 11 yrs. experience \$13,900 (full time)

teacher #6 – 17 yrs. experience \$17,000 (full time)

teacher #7 – 21 yrs. experience \$14,900 (full time)

support #1 – 2 yrs. experience - \$5,100 (part time – 25 hours/week)

support #2 – 3 yrs. experience - \$8,400 (part time – 30 hours/week)

AND WHEREAS retainment of good qualified employees is difficult when pay is at the levels they are currently at.

AND WHEREAS no other source to increase teacher's salaries can be found

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED that the question be posed to the students on the Spring 2000 ballot "Should the full-time students assess themselves an additional \$1.00 every Fall, Spring, and Summer semester for the SGA Daycare Center to be totally dedicated for employee salaries. This center provides quality and affordable childcare to full time students of the University of Louisiana at Lafayette."
