Whereas: The University of Louisiana at Lafayette is a major Research II University and students deserve adequate health care services comparable to other universities.

And Whereas: Over 4,000 students currently use the Health Services at UL Lafayette, paying \$50 a semester for off campus students and \$20 a semester for on campus students.

And Whereas: The UL Lafayette Student Health Care Services is in grave danger of being shut down because of inadequate funding and needs support by increasing its enrollment to all students.

And Whereas: The Health Services' doctors' hours will increase and have a greater availability to extend services to all students.

And Whereas: All fees will be used exclusively for the administration and operation of service rendered by the UL Lafayette Student Health Service Department.

And Whereas: This fee increase is necessary to improve and maintain the quality of services available to the students of UL Lafayette.

And Whereas: The Health Services Center currently offers these services, which will be increased and improved with the passage of this fee (See Attachment #1).

Be It Therefore Enacted that the question be posed to the students on the Spring 2002 ballot "Should the students of The University of Louisiana at Lafayette who carry 6 or more credit hours per semester (Fall and Spring) and 3 credit hours (Summer) pay \$20 in the fall, spring, and summer semesters to maintain the operation of the UL Lafayette Student Health Services, giving all students the opportunity to use the facility without any further charge throughout the year?".
