

University & BOR-SREB Ph.D. Fellowship Application

The University of Louisiana at Lafayette offers University Doctoral Fellowships to support the recruitment of superior Ph.D. students in the areas of Applied Language and Speech Sciences, Computer Engineering, Computer Science, Earth and Energy Science, English, Environmental and Evolutionary Biology, Francophone Studies, Mathematics, and Systems Engineering. University Doctoral Fellowships are competitively-awarded by individual Ph.D. programs to support three or four years of doctoral study depending on a fellows' previous graduate work. Fellowship recipients receive both an academic-year stipend and a waiver of tuition and mandatory fees for the academic year and summer sessions. The minimum stipend for University Ph.D. fellowship in 2024-2025 is \$22,000 and the value of an accompanying fellowship tuition/fee waiver is \$13,000+ for Louisiana residents and \$29,000+ for non-resident students (for Fall, Spring, and Summer enrollment).

As available, the Graduate School also awards Board of Regents/SREB Doctoral Scholars Fellowships funded jointly by UL Lafayette and the Louisiana Board of Regents to support the mission of the SREB-State Doctoral Scholars Program to increase faculty diversity in colleges and universities across region. BoR/SREB fellowship awards are restricted to U.S. citizens and permanent residents who are pursuing a Ph.D. degree and planning for a career in academia. Recipients of BOR-SREB Fellowships are nominated by individual Ph.D. programs to the Graduate School. These fellowships provide an annual stipend that ranges from \$22,000-\$30,000, a tuition/fee waiver (as above), added research/travel funding, and guaranteed funding for five years. Fellowships include membership in the SREB Doctoral Scholars Program and require participation in the SREB's annual Institute on Teaching and Mentoring.

Fellowship applications are due on February 1 and must be accompanied by a complete application for admission to graduate studies. (If the PhD program to which you are applying has an application deadline earlier than Feb. 1, it is recommended that this application be submitted by that date.) A complete application for admission to graduate studies at UL Lafayette includes completion of the online application; payment of a non-refundable application fee; submission (via the application portal) of all required transcripts; receipt of official TOEFL or IELTS scores (if applicable) that have been sent directly from the testing agency; receipt of three letters of recommendation; and receipt of any additional application materials required by the individual PhD program to which an applicant is seeking admission. This fellowship application should be uploaded via the application portal.

University Doctoral Fellowships begin in the Fall semester and are awarded to new students or those who began their doctoral studies in the Spring semester immediately prior. Contact the Graduate Coordinator for the individual Ph.D. program to determine fellowship availability with a Spring semester start.
