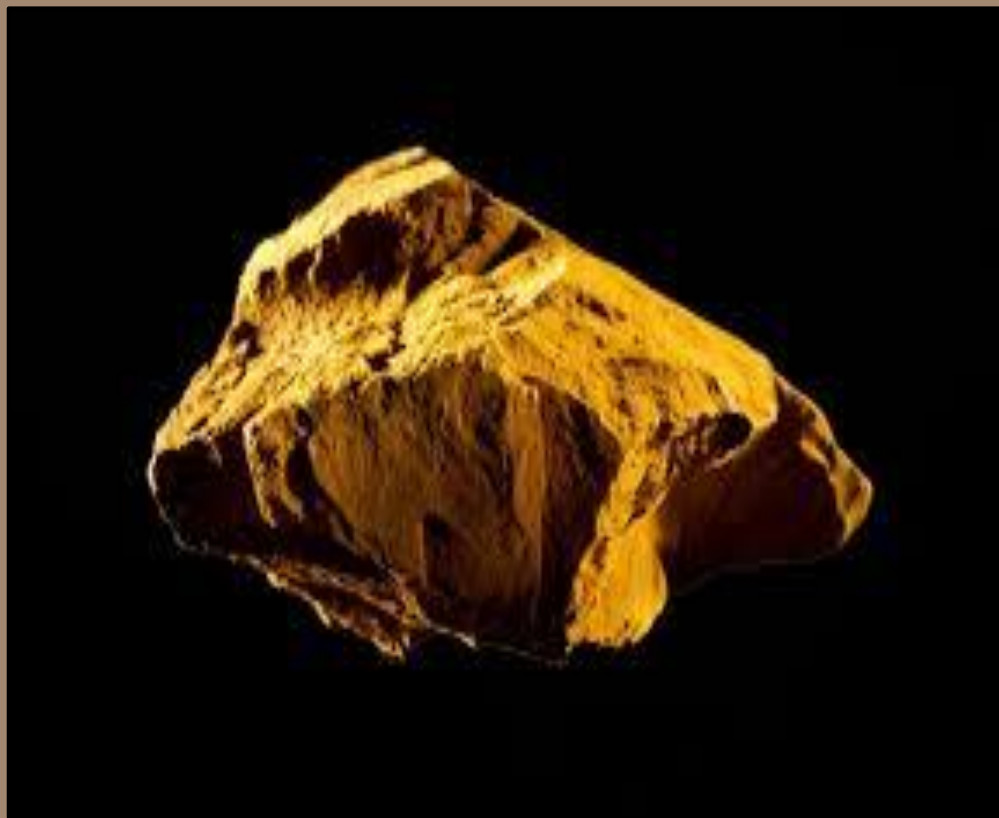


PAINT GRINDER

1) FIND ROCK OR DIRT

Lapis Lazuli

- semi-precious stone that was used to create blue pigment

+linseed oil

How to Paint like a Rococo Artist?

-Gilding-

1) Apply Gold Leaf Size (glue)

2) Apply Gold Leaf

3) Brush softly with clean brush

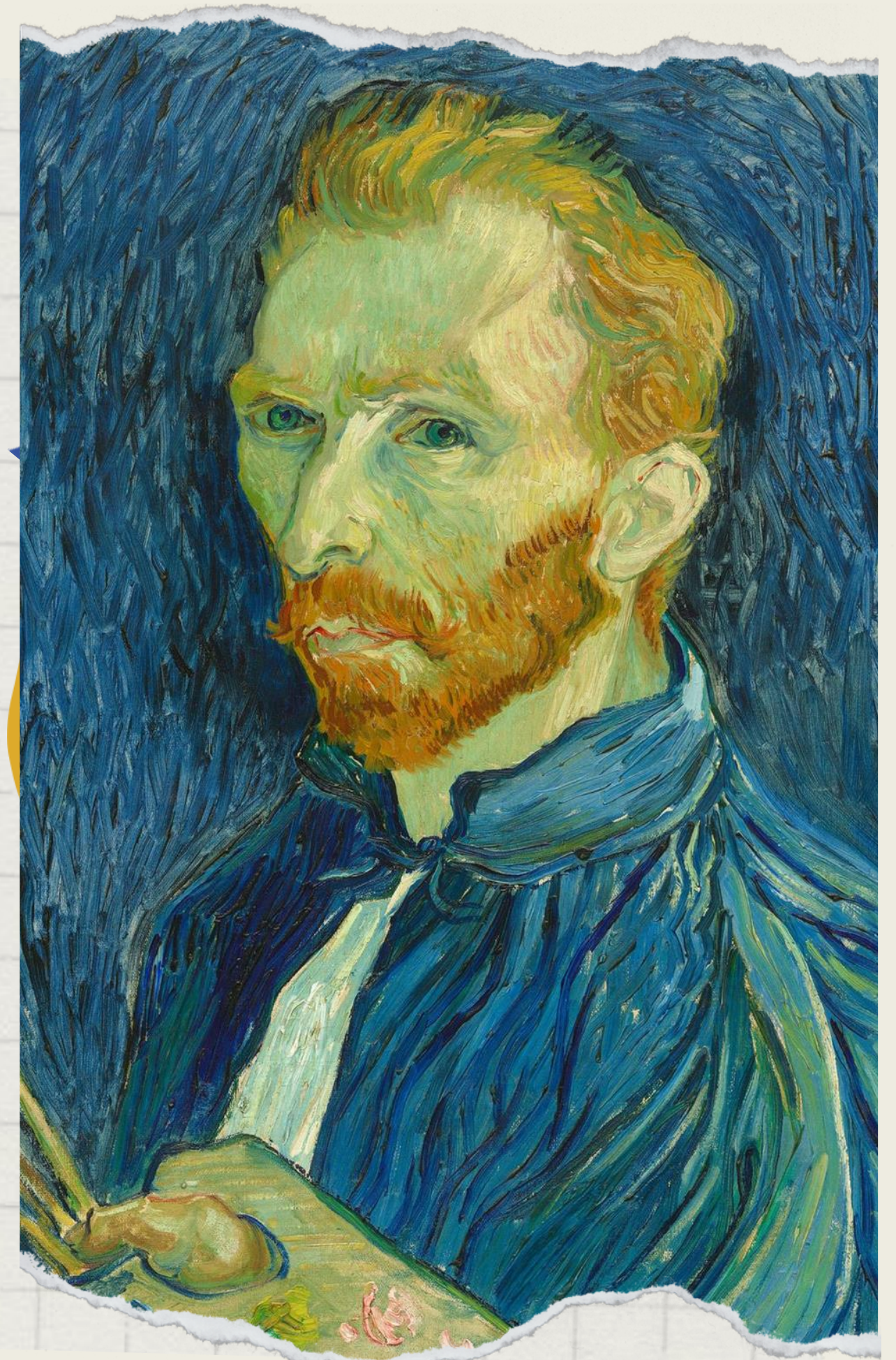




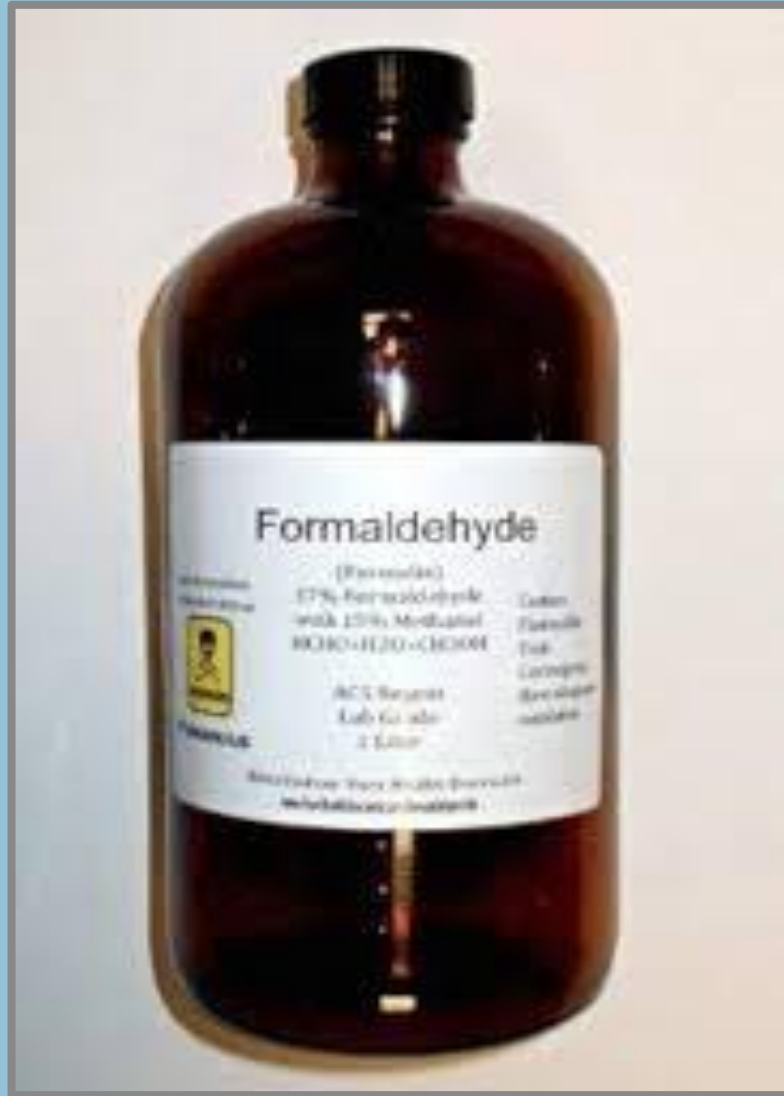

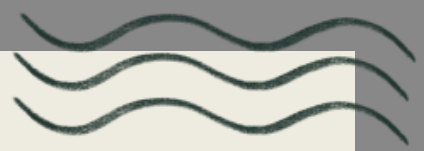
