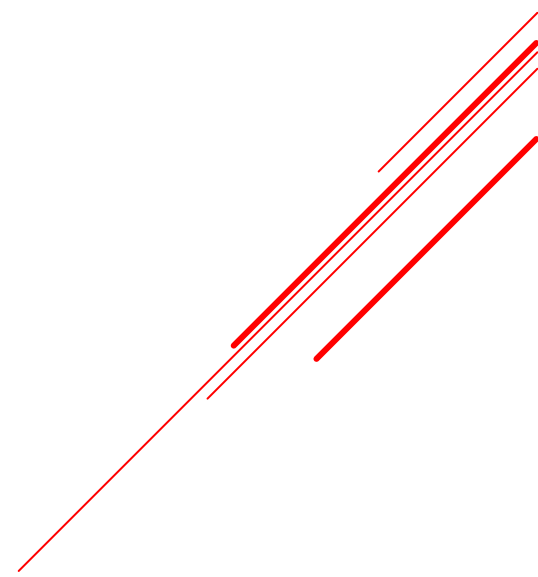

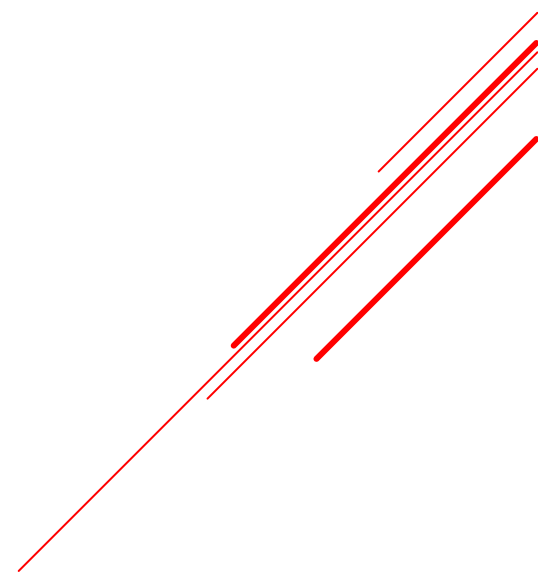

I. PERMITS

Parking Permits Are Required

- ▶ A new permit is required at the start of every semester.
 - ▶ Summer 2026 Semester Permits – available to purchase May 20
 - ▶ Check our webpage for updates:
<https://louisiana.edu/park/parking-permits>
- ▶ Virtual permits - License Plate Recognition (L.P.R)
 - ▶ No decals or hangtags. Your license plate number is how we recognize you.
 - ▶ A front license plate is required if backing into a parking space or pulling through.
 - ▶ License plates must always be visible from the aisle.

HOW TO PURCHASE A PERMIT

Online - Parking Portal

Go to ULINK> Campus Services> Parking and Transportation> access *my parking account* to launch to your Parking Portal.

Step 1: Register your vehicle. Enter the license plate information exactly as it appears on your vehicle registration.

No spaces or dashes.

Is it the letter O or the number 0?

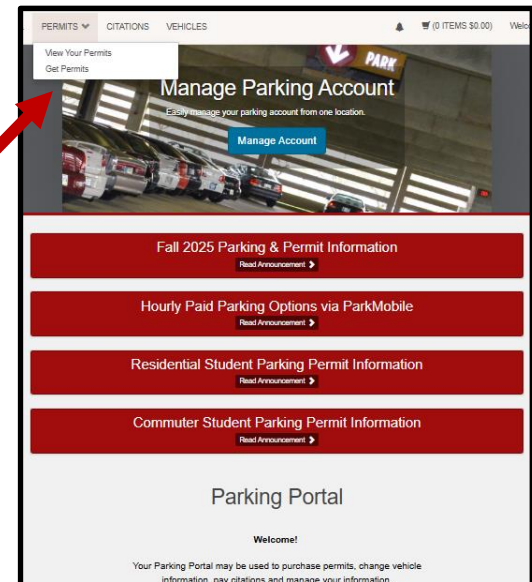
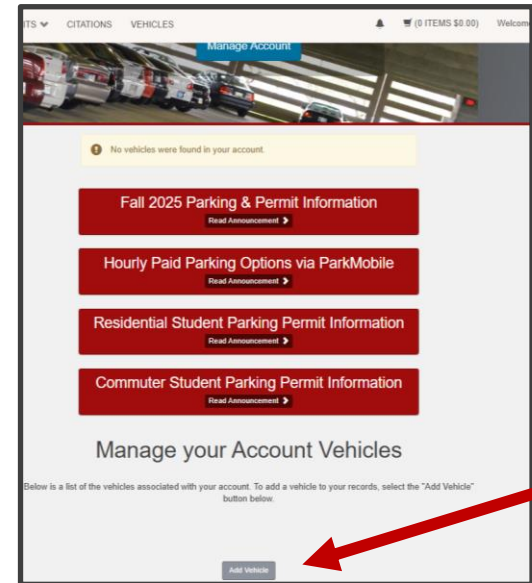
Check your vehicle registration to confirm!



Step 2: Get your permit. Select “Get Permits” at top of the page. Follow the prompts until payment is made. A confirmation email of the transaction is sent immediately. *No email confirmation means no permit.*

In Person (*in our office*)

Bring student ID, photo of your license plate and payment method. We accept debit/credit card, money order or Cajun Cash but not checks or cash.

Permits for Fall 2026

- Please check the Transportation Services Parking & Permits webpage in July for updates.

Residential Students:

- ▶ Contact our office to make any vehicle changes on your parking permit.
- ▶ Residential Handicap Permits are required to park in the handicap spaces in all residential parking zones.
- ▶ Changes in housing assignments after the start of the semester may require a change in your permit. There may be a \$10 transfer fee to change a permit. Not changing a permit will cause “Wrong Zone” citations.

* Prices are the typical semester permit prices and are subject to change. ** Local and state taxes will apply.

II. TRANSIT

UL BUS SCHEDULE

- ▶ Fall & Spring Semesters
 - ▶ Monday – Friday - 7:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m.
 - ▶ HINT: arrive early! Rush hour traffic causes slow downs for our buses too.
 - ▶ Route:
 - ▶ Cajun Field (Gate D)
 - ▶ Bourgeois Hall (Campus Bound)
 - ▶ Rex Street (Agnes Edwards)
 - ▶ Bourgeois Hall (Cajun Field Bound)
- ▶ Saturday and Sunday
 - ▶ Closed
- ▶ Summer 2026 (May 11-Aug.21)
 - ▶ Transit services suspended until Fall '26 semester

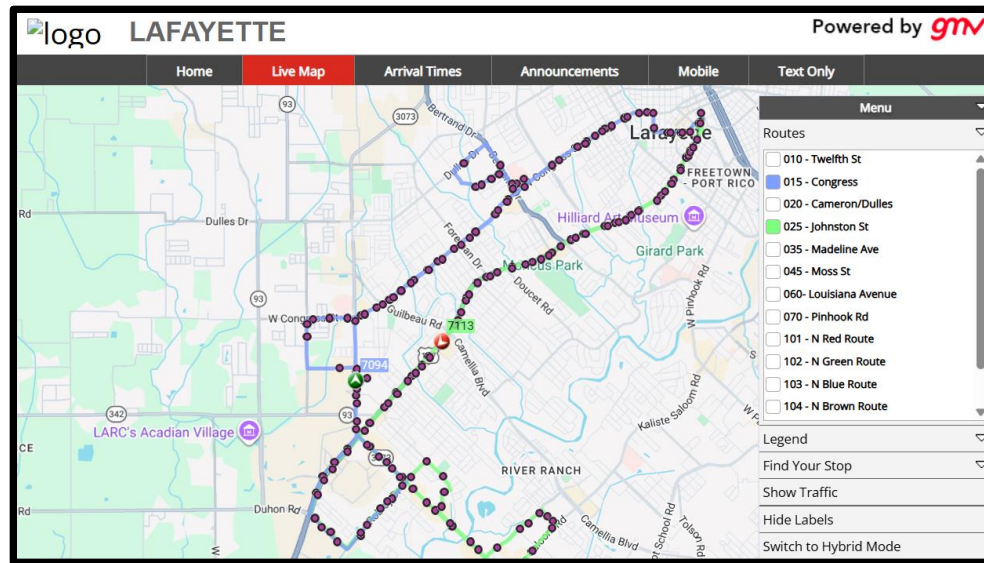


CAMPUS SHUTTLES

 - ▶ Health Sciences (611 St. Landry)
 - ▶ Student Union
 - ▶ Rex St.
 - ▶ Legacy (Near Cafe' Fleur De Lis)
 - ▶ Cajun Village (S. Campus Drive)
 - ▶ Heritage (Club House)
 - ▶ Saturday and Sunday - closed
- ▶ Summer 2026 (May 11-August 21)
 - ▶ Monday – Friday: 7:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.
 - ▶ Student Union
 - ▶ Rex St.
 - ▶ Legacy (Near Cafe' Fleur De Lis)
 - ▶ Cajun Village (S. Campus Drive)
 - ▶ Heritage (Club House)
 - ▶ Bourgeois (Gym Side)
 - ▶ Health Sciences (611 St. Landry)
 - ▶ Saturday, Sunday & Holidays - closed
- ▶ The Central 'HUB' is the Rex St stop where all buses & shuttles stop. Use them to get around campus! For example:
 - ▶ If you are at the Student Union and want to go to Cajun Field, you would need to get on the Shuttle at the Student Union then get off at the Rex St stop and hop on a bus at the bus stop to go to Cajun Field.
 - ▶ Or if you are in Agnes Edwards Hall and want to go to Starbucks in The Union, get on the shuttle at the Rex St stop in front of the building then get off at the stop in front of The Union.

Transit & shuttle services are not available when the University is officially closed. (Holidays, Emergencies)

CITY OF LAFAYETTE TRANSIT SYSTEM



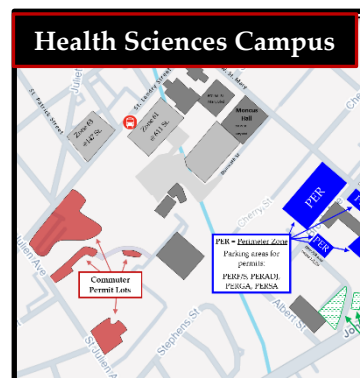
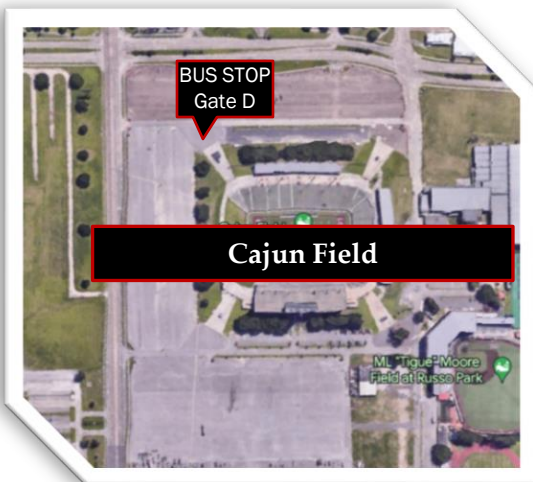
- ▶ Lafayette Transit System (LTS) connects neighborhoods and businesses throughout Lafayette. It is a public service of the City of Lafayette available to all. There are six different routes. For more information including fares, discount passes, routes and more visit www.ridelts.com

III. PARKING: COMMUTER STUDENTS

CAJUN FIELD

- ▶ Free commuter permit required each fall and spring semester
 - ▶ Two vehicles allowed per permit.
- ▶ Bus service to & from campus 7 a.m. – 10 p.m.
- ▶ Transit services suspended for summer terms



GIRARD PARK CIRCLE GARAGE

- ▶ Floors 1-3 - Hourly
 - ▶ \$5.25/first 2 hours (minimum) then \$1.05/hour thereafter
 - ▶ Payment made via the ParkMobile app or website
- ▶ Floors 3-6 - Permit
 - ▶ \$350 fall or spring semester, including taxes
 - ▶ Closest commuter student permit option to all buildings on campus
 - ▶ Guaranteed parking every class day

ZONE 17C

- ▶ Specified parking lots on south side of the main campus.
 - ▶ UL Main Campus & Health Sciences Campus Zone Map indicates location of the two Zone 17C parking lots.
 - ▶ \$40 each fall and spring semester & \$20 summer

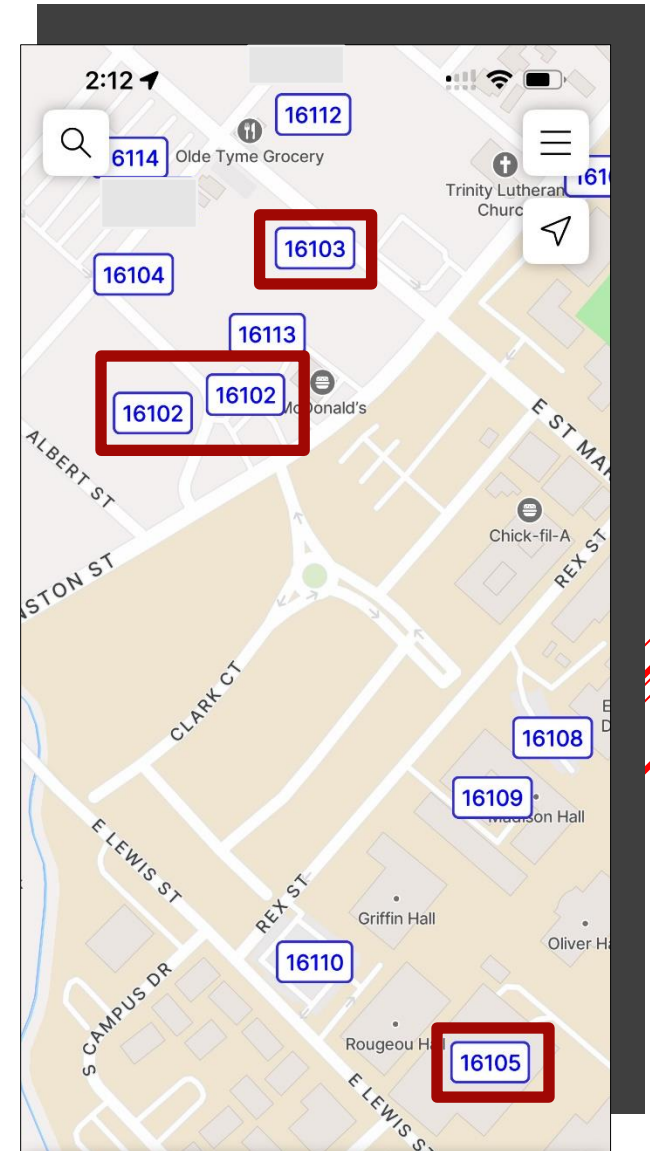

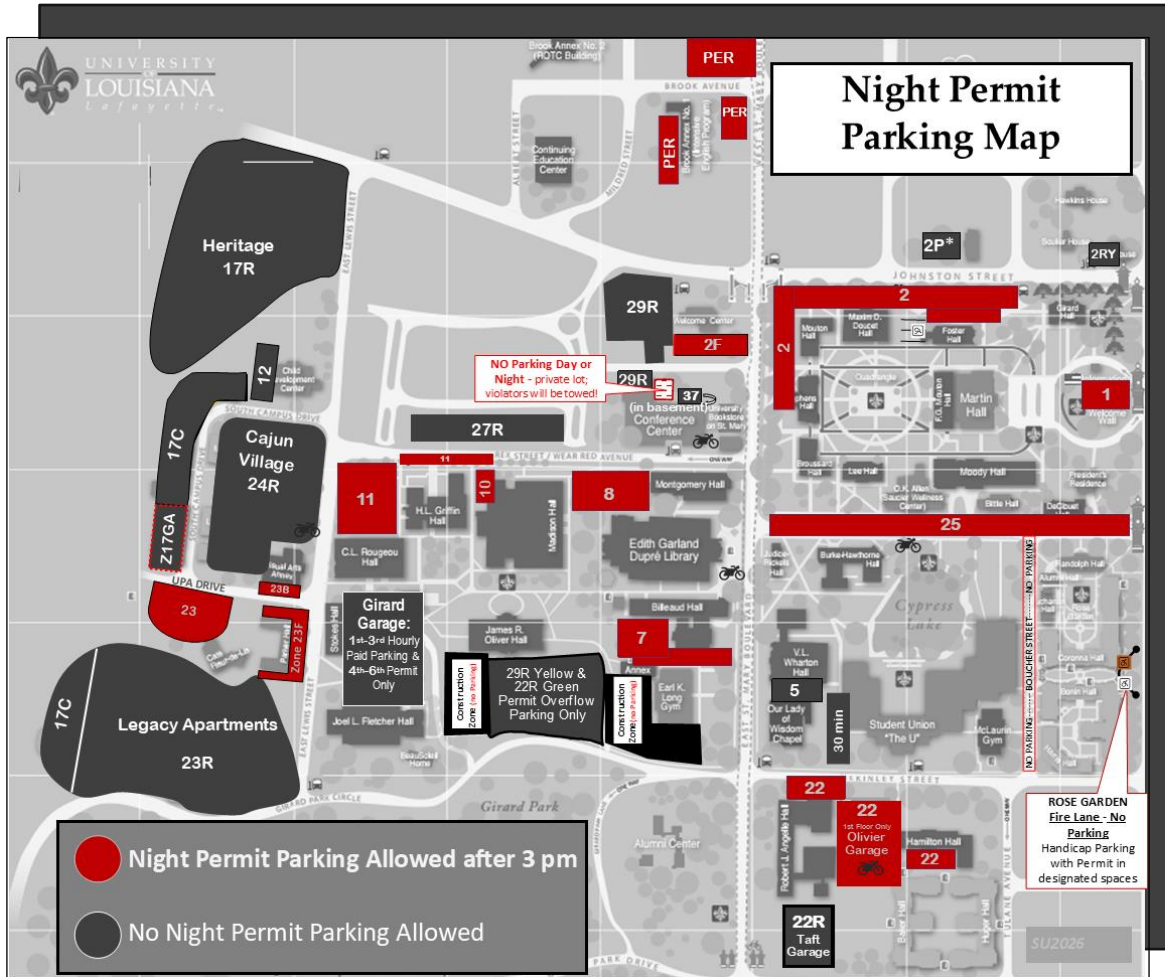

NIGHT PERMITS



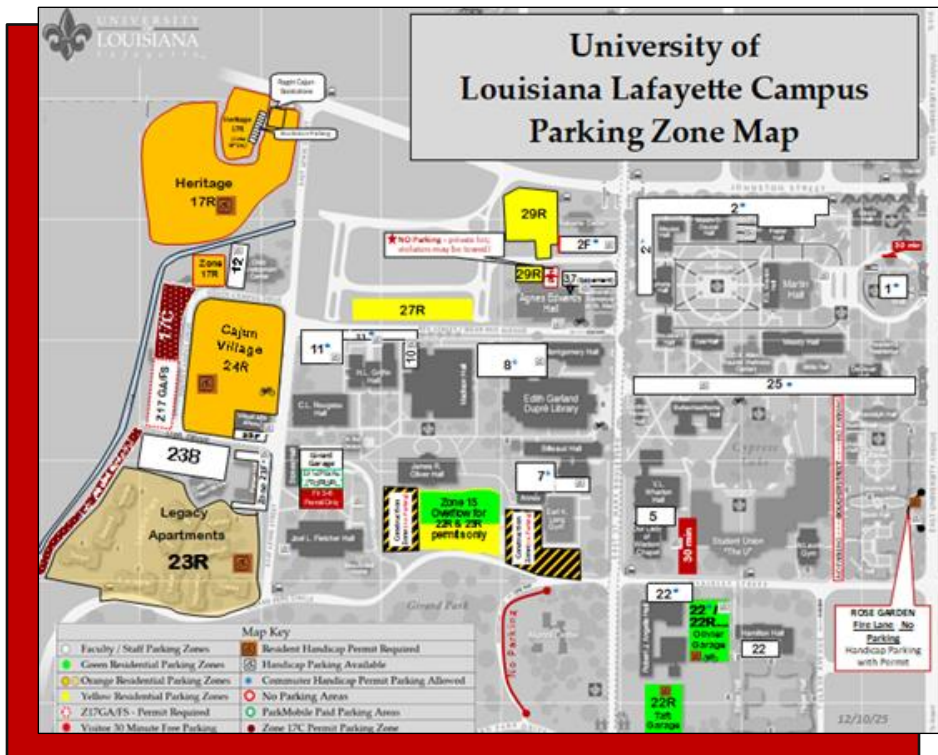
- ▶ Night permits allow commuter students to park in the specific areas after 3:00 p.m. except for:
 - ▶ Girard Parking Tower
 - ▶ Residential zones
 - ▶ Reserved spaces
 - ▶ Designated handicap parking areas
- ▶ Commuter students may have a commuter & night permit.

III. PARKING: RESIDENTIAL STUDENTS

PERMITS

- ▶ Required each semester
- ▶ Based on the housing assignment
- ▶ One permit per residential student & one car per permit.
- ▶ Residential student must be the driver of the vehicle.



- ▶ Green Residential / Zone 22R
 - ▶ Baker, Bonin, Coronna, Harris, and Huger Hall residents
 - ▶ Parking locations include Olivier Tower floors 3-6 and Taft Garage any floor in Taft Garage. Overflow parking area is gravel area of Yellow/Green lot (see map).
- ▶ Yellow Residential / Zone 29R
 - ▶ Agnes Edwards Hall residents
 - ▶ Parking locations include Zones 29R and 27. Overflow parking area is gravel area of Yellow/Green lot (see map).
- ▶ Orange Residential / Zone 23R or Zone 17R
 - ▶ Zone 23R - Legacy Park apartments - Parking locations include the parking lots surrounding the Legacy apartment buildings only. Overflow parking locations - none.
 - ▶ Zone 17R - Heritage apartments - Parking locations include the parking lots surrounding the Heritage apartment buildings. Overflow parking locations - none.

III. PARKING: HANDICAP PERMITS

- ▶ **Commuter and Residential Handicap Parking permits** are available for students who submit state-issued handicap credentials. Credentials must be in the student's name:
 - ▶ Hangtag or vehicle registration, if a permanent handicap license plate.
 - ▶ Mobility Impaired Card
 - ▶ Driver's License
- ▶ Email scans of all credentials to geauxpark@louisiana.edu
- ▶ Permit may be purchased online or in-office after receipt of confirmation of credentials.
- ▶ All permits are active for one semester only.

COMMUTER

- ▶ Commuter Handicap permit allows parking in the faculty/staff zones, except for reserved spaces.
- ▶ Permit parking in the Girard Garage is restricted to first floor designated handicap spaces. Payment or permit required in all other areas of the Girard Garage.
- ▶ It does not allow parking in handicap or regular spaces in residential zones.

RESIDENTIAL

- ▶ The residential handicap permit is required to park in designated handicap parking space in the student's residential parking zone only.
- ▶ It does not allow parking in handicap or regular parking spaces anywhere else on campus.

IV. ENFORCEMENT

- ▶ Parking is enforced
Monday – Friday: 7:00 a.m.
– 9:00 p.m. however we do reserve the right to enforce 24/7.
- ▶ Includes days when classes are not in session (ex. Fall break, between semesters, etc.).
- ▶ Does not include days when university offices are closed such as holidays.
- ▶ Review the Traffic Code for all parking rules.
- ▶ Two Types of Enforcement:
 - ▶ University vehicle - LPR
 - ▶ On-foot
- ▶ Enforcement officers are confirming vehicles:
 - ▶ have an active permit;
 - ▶ are in the correct zone/permitted area;
 - ▶ the plate is visible from the aisle;
 - ▶ the vehicle is parked correctly
 - ▶ and more.

V. CITATIONS

Citation Notification

- ▶ Paper citation placed on windshield
- ▶ Email to the student who registered the vehicle the following day.

Citation Checklist

- ▶ Do you have an active permit?
- ▶ Did you register **and** link your vehicle to your permit?
- ▶ Are you parked in your permitted zone?
- ▶ Did you park head-in to the parking space so your license plate can be scanned?
- ▶ Does the license plate information match on the citation, your permit and your vehicle?
- ▶ Check the UL Traffic Code for other possible violations.

ALL ABOUT CITATIONS

Consequences

▶ Holds

- ▶ A hold is automatically placed on the student's university account until fine is paid.
- ▶ Holds prevent registration, drop/add classes, viewing grades and getting a permit.
- ▶ After citations are paid, holds are removed automatically on a pre-set schedule.

▶ Immobilizations / Boots

- ▶ A vehicle is eligible for immobilization the day after it accumulates the third unpaid citation.
 - ▶ Email notification sent when a vehicle is immobilized.
 - ▶ Immobilizations are a separate citation with \$110 fine.
 - ▶ Immobilized vehicles may be towed or remain immobilized at the discretion of Transportation Services if the balance due is not paid by 4 p.m.

Citation Appeals

▶ 1st level

- ▶ Must be submitted online within 4 class days or 96 hours.
- ▶ Appeals Officer will review and respond within 2-14 days.

▶ 2nd level

- ▶ Parking Appeals Committee meets once a month during fall & spring.
- ▶ Sign up in person in our lobby.

VI. BIKES

Parking

- ▶ Lock bikes & e-scooters to bike racks only
- ▶ Bikes may be confiscated if not locked in approved locations

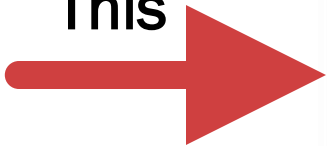
Registration

- ▶ Bikes may be registered at Lafayette Police Department if desired.
- ▶ Keep a record of your bike: picture, brand, color & serial number.

Safety

- ▶ St. Mary Street has bike lanes shared with vehicles at intersections.
- ▶ Rules of the Road
 - ▶ Ride with traffic, not against
 - ▶ Ride defensively
