Fellowships Committee

A report reviewed by A. Mayeaux on behalf of R. Nelson, noting that Modifications made to the application process greatly assisted in the consistency of information provided by the applicants. He also noted that they discovered that length of time the applicants program needs to be more prominently listed and considered by the committee. The committee recommend making the length of time more prominently displayed and ultimately, reminding the committee of the need to consider this variable in future cycles. In addition, The Committee received and evaluated 25 applications for the Academic Year 2024-2025 Dissertation Completion Fellowship Awards. Recommendation was made to award all 20 of the available fellowships to the top ranked applicants. The committee also identified an alternate applicant, if one of the fellowships became available. Should more fellowships become available, it is the committee's recommendation that we reconvene to determine how to proceed with the remaining applicants.

10 **Doctoral Research Grant Awards**

18 **Request for Continued Graduate Faculty Membership for Departing Faculty Member**

19 A. Mayeaux introduced a request that had been submitted by Dr. Ryan Nelson on behalf of the
20 Department of Communicative Disorder to the Graduate Council that a faculty member who has who is
21 now emeritus be allowed to continue on two graduate student thesis committees and count as one of
22 the three required UL Graduate Faculty. It was discussed that this example speaks to the need for
23 adding an emeritus category for graduate faculty status. Motion made to accept the request. Motion
