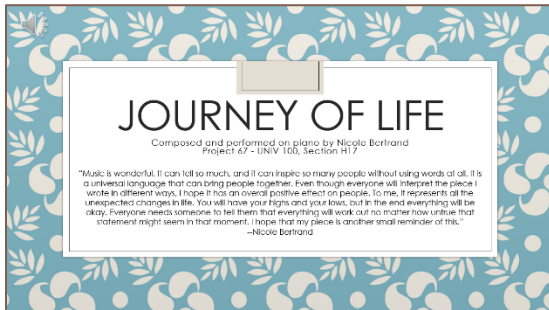

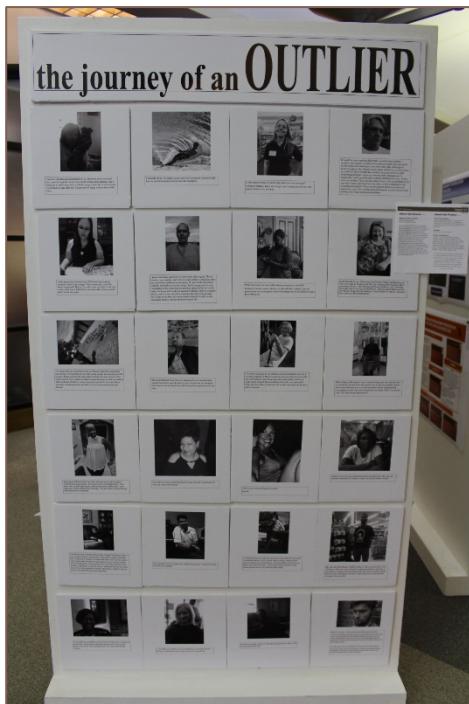

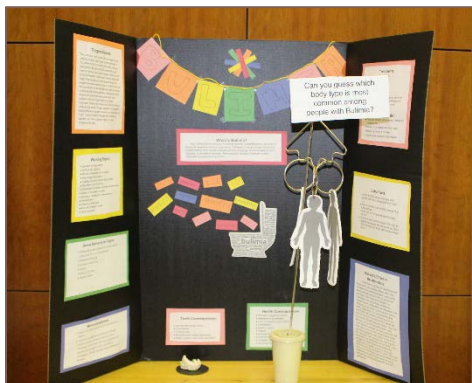

Walk On Water Rules

Walk-On-Water project is a design competition for self-propelled buoyancy shoes. Original and innovative designs are encouraged. As such, minor modifications of items such as boats, surfboards, body boards, etc. are not within the spirit of the project.

The following rules govern the competition:

1. Each project must consist of two separate and mirror image buoyancy shoes, not to exceed 8' in length, such that one person can operate and control the shoes using only his or her feet. External propulsion devices are prohibited. This is a human powered apparatus.
2. All materials are allowable; however, shoes designed from recyclable materials are encouraged.
3. Expenditures for each team shall be limited to \$100.00. Estimated value of donated materials shall be included in the total.
4. A slalom course must be traversed from one end of the pool at Sourgois Hall to the other.
5. The "shoe-pilot" will be required to maintain a vertical position above the shoes at all times.
6. The shoes cannot in any way engage any part of the body above the knees. A mechanism for quick release of the shoe pilot from the buoyancy shoes is mandatory.
7. Helmet must be worn in the pool at all times.
8. If your team wants to practice outside of designated class times please contact Dana Bekurs at least 3 weekdays in advance so she can reserve the pool.
9. There will be a in class time day to test the water shoes.

Failure to comply with the safety guidelines may lead to disqualification or a failing grade.

The Engineering Design Process

- Step 1: Recognize the need
- Step 2: Define the Problem
- Step 3: Plan and manage the project
- Step 4: Gather Information
- Step 5: Brainstorm
- Step 6: Engineering Analysis
- Step 7: Select the best alternative
- Step 8: Construct the design
- Step 9: Prototype

Although the Design process is broken down into steps, it is important to remember that any step can be revisited at anytime!

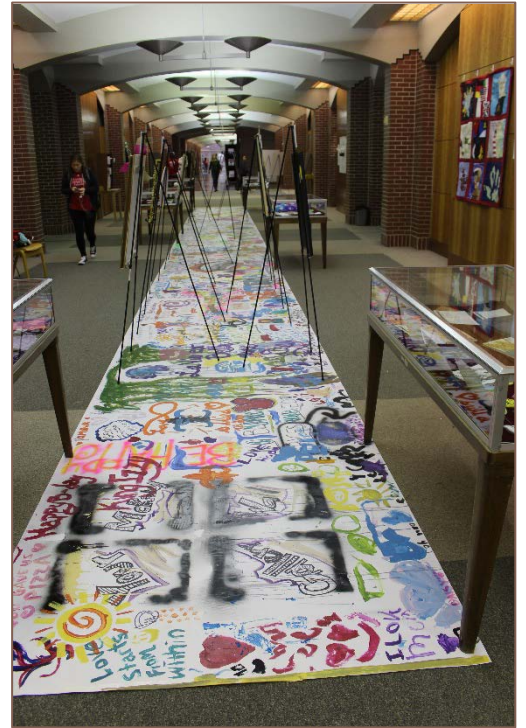
