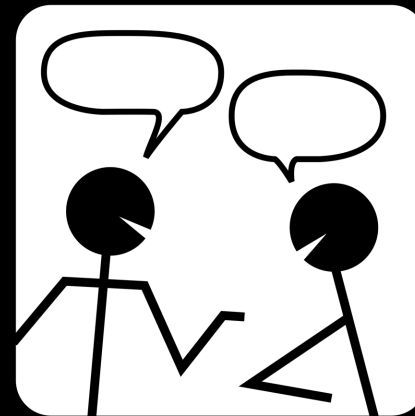



Entering College: Moodleing and Mingling Through the First Semester
