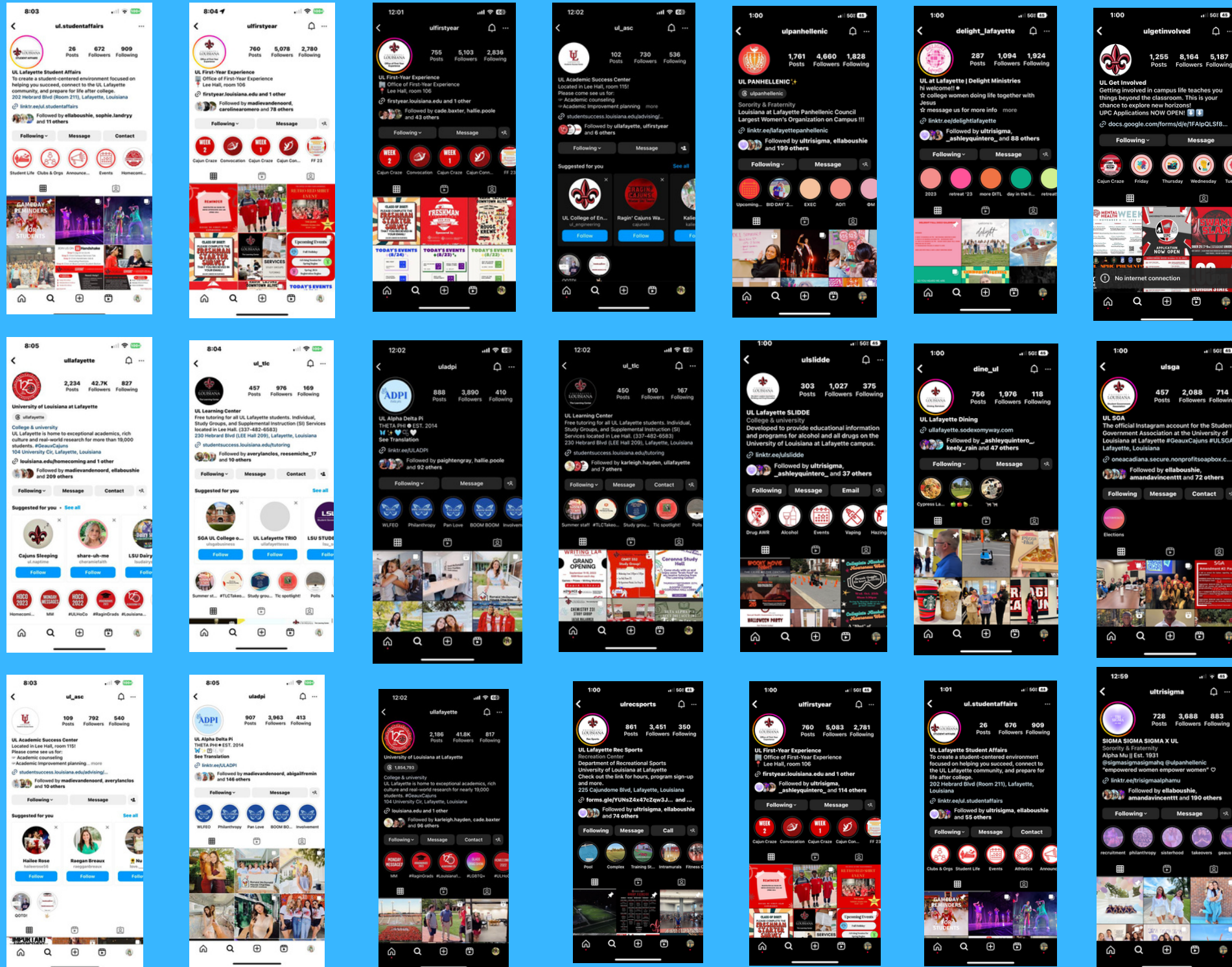


CHAT AND CHEW

Following as many UL platforms is important to stay updated and stay involved. The more you know the more you can do!

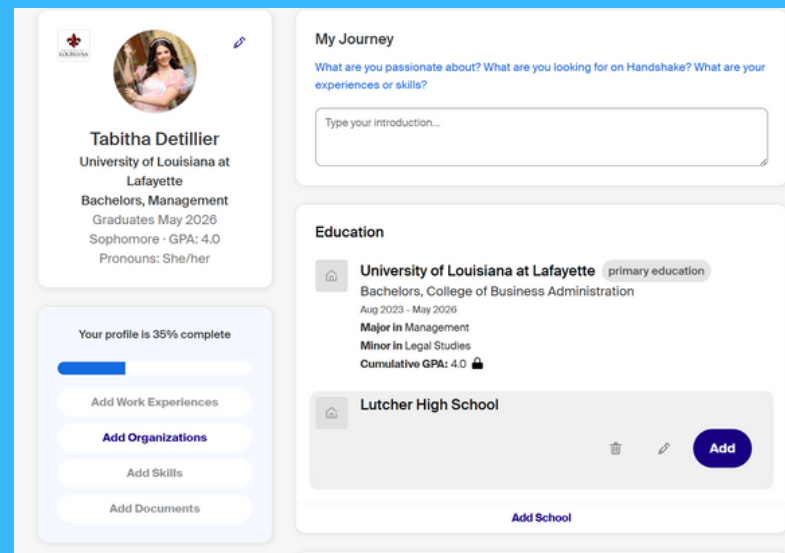
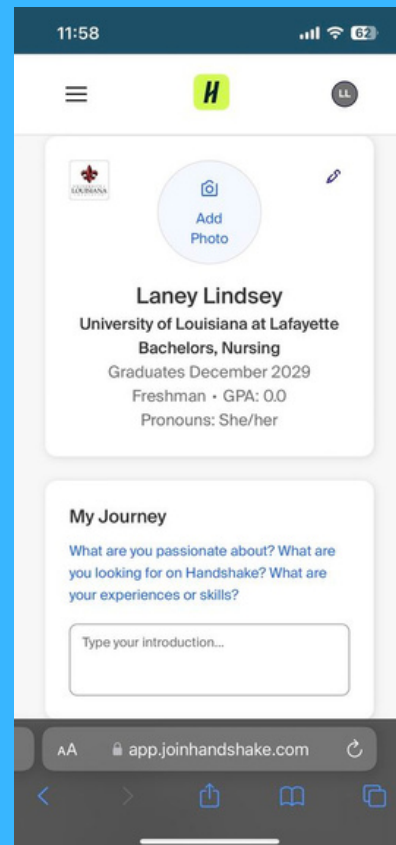
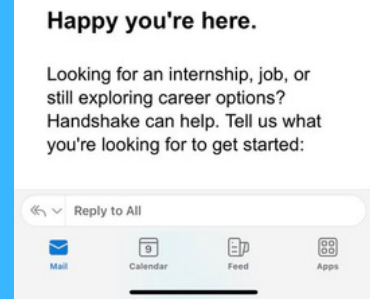
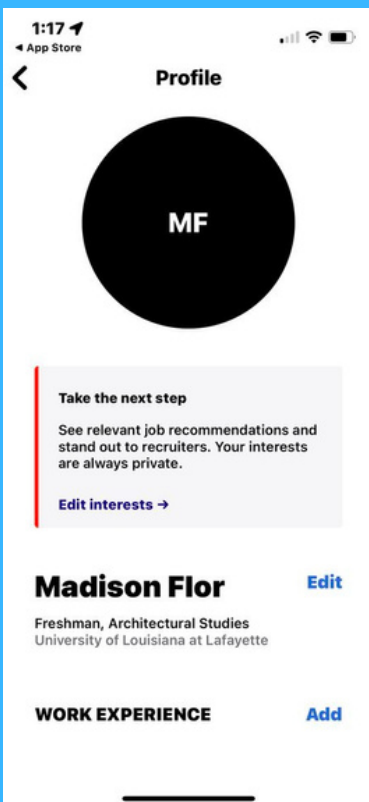
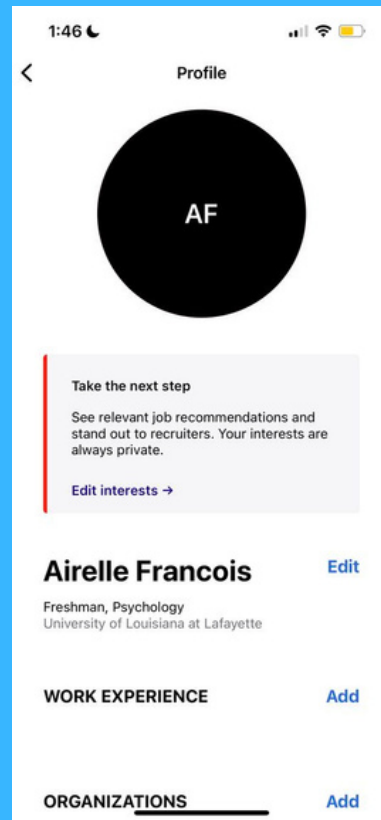
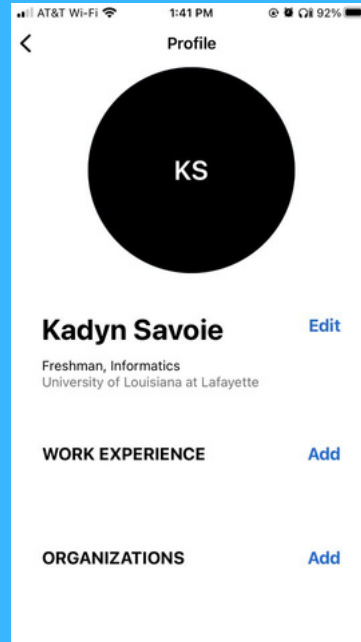
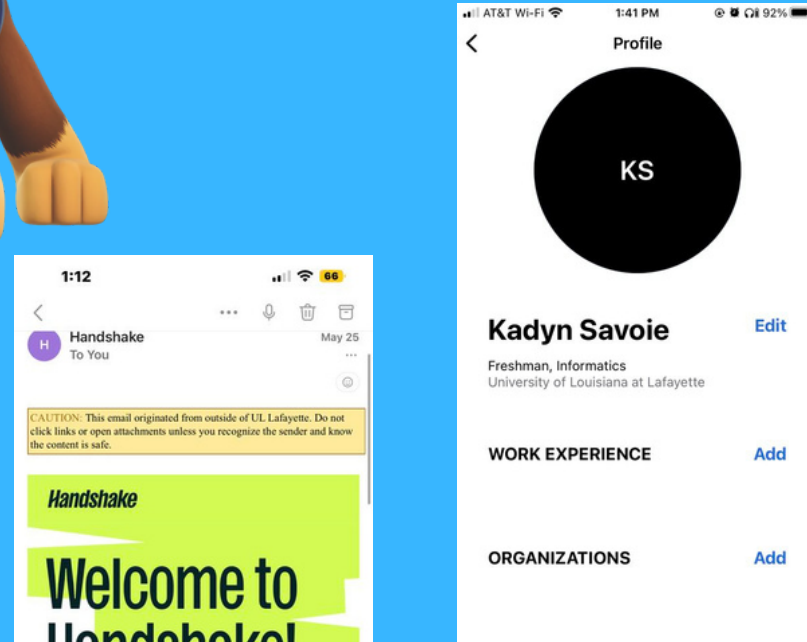




HANDSHAKE
