To the Student

To aid in the preparation of a dissertation proposal and to determine the weaknesses and strengths in the student's preparation, students must complete and defend a qualifying paper that consists of a comprehensive review of the literature on a topic selected by the student. The qualifying paper is required by the Ed.D. degree program in place of the general comprehensive examination. The Qualifying Paper (QP) Committee is charged with evaluating the student's qualifying paper and is composed of a minimum of two faculty members. In all cases, this committee must be chaired by a faculty member who possesses Level 2 membership on the Graduate Faculty; this includes adjunct faculty who are members of the UL Lafayette Graduate Faculty.
