









### Health & Safety

Supply of masks and hand sanitizers for students

Protection barriers to offices that provide student services such as Bursar's Office, Financial, Aid, Advising, etc.

Guidelines for social distancing and for wearing face masks (when, where, enforcement)

Increased need to manage student anxiety and fears of being exposed to virus.

### Degree Completion/Course Availability

Ensure flexibility so time to degree is not negatively impacted while not diluting integrity of degree

### Support Services

Counseling Services – Prepare for an uptick in students needing counseling. Continue to provide telecounseling.

Health Centers – Prepare to test and staff adequately given the current climate.

Student Life – Additional space needed to accommodate social distancing in residence halls, cafeterias, health centers, rec centers and other areas where students typically gather.

Disability Services – Consideration should be given to other ways for registering for services in addition to face-to-face (i.e. Google Meet). Prepare testing centers in accordance to social distancing measures.
